

JOB DESCRIPTION

Role: Tax Trainee Reporting to: Tax Advisers/Manager/Partner Team: Private Clients

Overview of role

This is a training role commencing with the fundamentals of tax compliance progressing through to being able to perform high quality tax compliance and tax advisory work.

Main responsibilities and duties

- 1. Request client information (either from client or audit team).
- 2. Generate tax return or computation, assessing impact of each piece of information.
- 3. Address gueries on the return with the client.
- 4. Pass file to manager/tax advisor for review.
- 5. Make any amendments required.
- 6. Send return to client with letter detailing liabilities and any tax saving opportunities.
- 7. Receive signed return and forward to Revenue within deadline.
- 8. Liaise with Revenue statement on account.
- 9. Communicate need to pay to client.
- 10. Prepare Inland Revenue forms as appropriate and ensure deadlines are met.
- 11. Assist with preparation of client bill.

Other Responsibilities

- 1. Regularly update your technical knowledge, via CPD and other suitable opportunities.
- 2. Positive involvement with tax advisory work relevant to your skill level.

Communications

- 1. Clients regarding information required, liabilities, deadlines to be met, returns to be signed, tax saving opportunities.
- 2. Partners regarding getting correspondence signed, escalating client issues.
- 3. Other tax team members to gain technical support and review.
- 4. Audit team regarding information on tax computations and other tax issues.

Inland Revenue

- 1. Problems and issues.
- 2. Client aueries.
- 3. Issues raised by the Revenue regarding client returns.
- 4. Managing deadlines.



Decision-making parameters

- 1. Prioritisation of work.
- 2. Treatment of items within a tax return.

Qualifications and skills

- 1. Studying or prepared to study for ATT, followed by CTA, if appropriate.
- 2. Practical and technical tax knowledge.
- 3. Basic accounts knowledge.
- 4. IT packages (Excel, Word). Training will be given on tax specific software.
- 5. Communication.
- 6. Organisation and attention to detail.
- 7. Client focus.
- 8. Problem solving.
